OUR Lightkeeper's Shipwreck Discovery Tour takes tourists off the beaten track, immersing them in the fascinating natural and man-made history of Cape Otway – home to mainland Australia's most significant lighthouse.

This off-road adventure into the Great Otway National Park allows you to walk in the footsteps of our first lightkeeper in 1848.

Guides will share amazing stories of shipwrecks, survivors, daring pioneers, and rugged conditions endured by lightkeepers.

Koala sightings are virtually guaranteed and we regularly see other wildlife including wallabies, kangaroos, echidnas and a variety of birds. Whales can be spotted between June & September.

We visit:

- Lighthouse – tour of grounds & climb to the top of the tower
- Lightkeeper's Café – for scones, cream & jam, plus tea/coffee
- Parker River Inlet – difficult landing point for keepers' supplies
- Blanket Bay – beachfront stone chimney ruins
- Shipwreck – sands reveal anchor & ribs of Eric the Red
- Telegraph Station – 1850s groundbreaking communications
- World War II Radar Bunker – keeping an eye on enemy forces

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Climb to the top of the lighthouse for stunning views

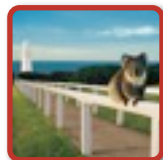
